



Using Captivate

Overview

Many demonstrations on the MAIS website use Captivate. A Captivate presentation records actions initiated by a user in response to information displayed on a computer. It captures the screen, cursor, and movements at the time of the recording and presents the information in a Web browser window.

Web Browser Window with Captivate Presentation

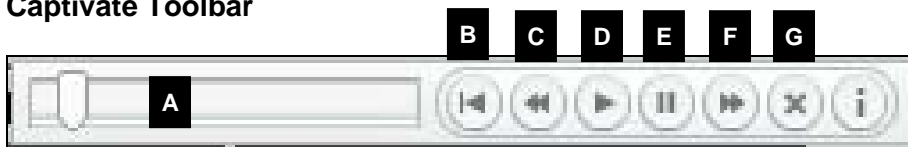


Notes:

- Most presentations include audio, therefore make sure that you have the speaker volume on your computer adjusted accordingly.
- The size of the Captivate window displayed in the Web browser cannot be adjusted.

1. Maximize your web browser window to ensure that you are viewing the entire Captivate window.
2. Use the Captivate Toolbar to control the presentation.

Captivate Toolbar



Letter	Field/Button	Description
A	Playback Bar	Indicates the current progress of playback. Slide the lever along the bar to move to another location within the presentation.
B	Rewind	Click this button to play the presentation from the beginning.
C	Back	Click this button to move backward within the presentation.
D	Play	Click this button to resume playback of the presentation.
E	Pause	Click this button to pause the presentation during playback.
F	Forward	Click this button to move forward within the presentation.
G	Exit	Click this button to exit the presentation.
