














Project Management Methodology Workflow Diagram Key

This document identifies shapes and standards used in the Project Management Methodology process workflow diagram.

Diagram Key

Shape	Shape Name	Description
	Start Process	Indicates the beginning of the Project Management Methodology process for an approved project.
	Required Process/Step	Indicates a required process or step.
	Process/Step Numbers	X000 numbers (i.e. 1000) are processes, XX00 numbers (i.e. 1200) are activities or sub-processes, XXX0 numbers (i.e. 1230) are steps. Process/Step Numbers that are <u>blue underlined</u> indicate that a workflow diagram exists for that process/step. Click anywhere in the box to navigate to it.
	Related Steps	Reflects steps that are related and often completed simultaneously.
	Optional Step	Indicates an optional step or one that is not always required.
	Inputs	A document icon with a text label above a step indicates an expected input to that step. Input text that is <u>blue underlined</u> indicates a link to a blank template, reference material, or related process. Clicking the link will navigate you to the external reference or launch the appropriate application and template.

	<p>Off-Page Reference</p>	<p>Indicates a link to another page in the diagram. Click to navigate to the referenced page.</p>
 <p>Project Document Repository</p>	<p>Database Icon</p>	<p>Provides sample directory for storing project documents.</p>
	<p>Predefined Process</p>	<p>Indicates another existing process with which there may be relevant overlap.</p>
	<p>End Process</p>	<p>Indicates the end of the project and concludes the Project Management Methodology process.</p>
